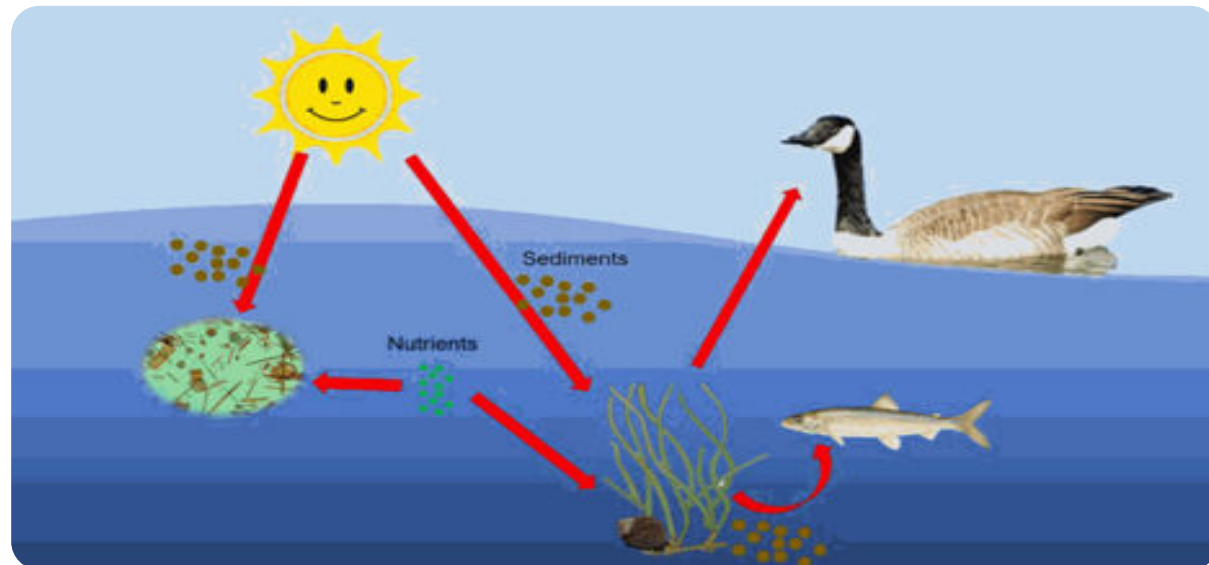

The activity allowed for a better understanding of the different components in the research project and why they are all equally important to understand environmental changes along the coast.

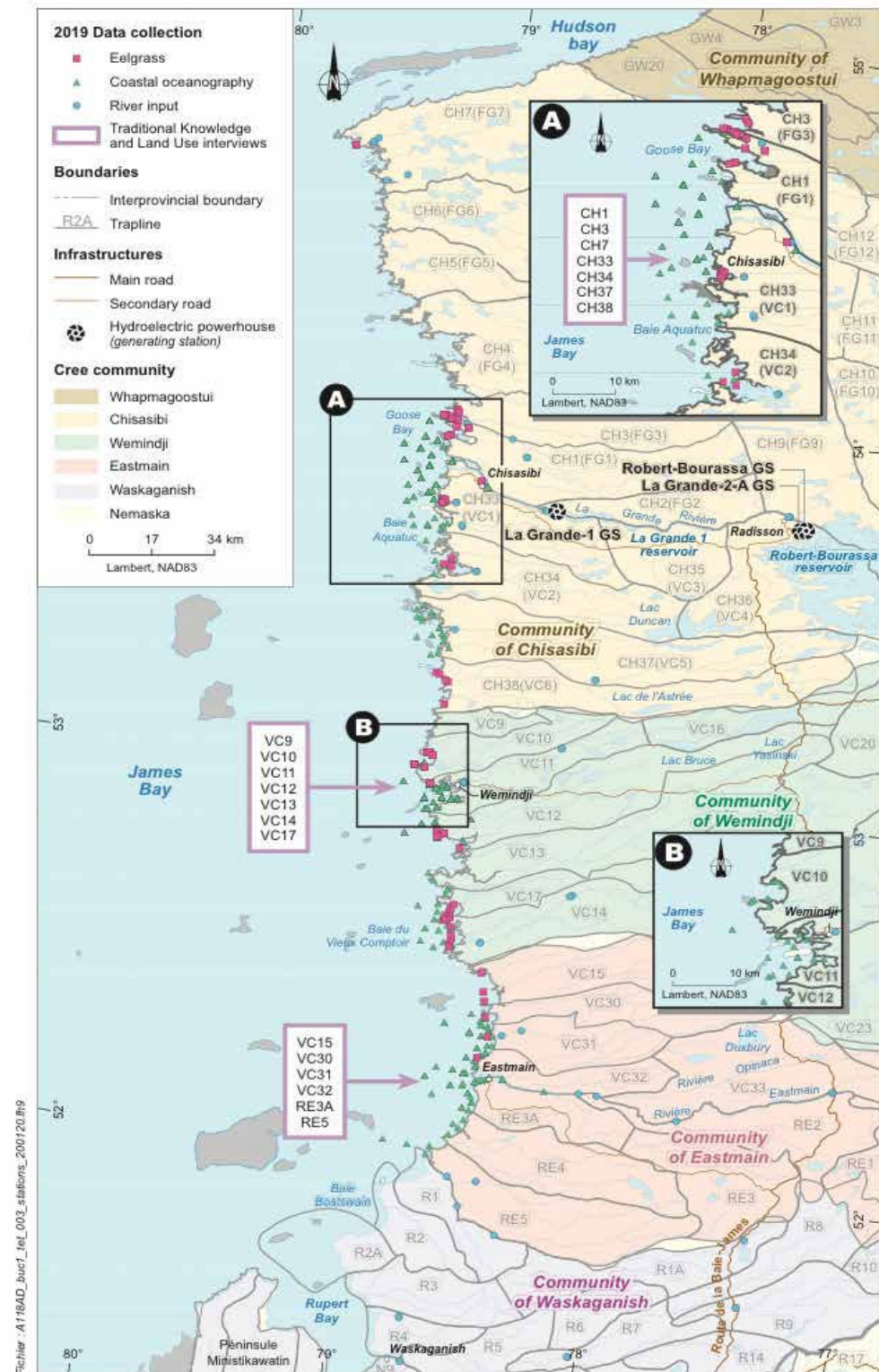


Simplified view of ecosystem puzzle
